Open letter to a young artist

Times change and nostalgia is alien to me. I would be the last to say that 'the good old days' ever existed. It's the present that counts, the past is forgotten and the future is another new present.

I hope that as a young artist you meet someone like Gérard Violette. I have rarely encountered anyone who was so essential about what his 'house' signifies, in a society that has other concerns than art.

Gérard Violette has never been afraid of the obscure, was never taken aback by the hermetic, always took risks and could only stand and watch as people ran out of his 'house' slamming the door as they went. He was never resigned as he watched, but extremely militant. He grabbed 'his' audience by the neck and challenged them to prove that what was on stage was not essential.

And increasingly the doors were no longer slammed.

Dear young artist, do not allow yourself to be browbeaten by the accountants of our times, avoid the enlightened grocers who consider that in spite of everything the books should balance at the expense of beauty, using audience numbers as an excuse. Meet the right people!

There are not many of them, the radical Gérards of the day. But you need them so as to seek out the much-needed hysteria, carefree and in all agitation, in the hope of giving the soul of our society extra oxygen with your accursed arts.

For Gérard everything will be fine; for you too, I hope.

Perhaps we should establish a prize: the 'Gérard' for best theatre director. What do you think?

THE NEXT FEW MONTHS AT NEEDCOMPANY:

The Deer House: the new production by Jan Lauwers & Needcompany will open at the Salzburger Festspiele and in the autumn will be on in Brussels, Antwerp and Zurich.

Sad Face/Happy Face – Three Stories on Human Nature: this marathon session, in which *Isabella's room*, *The Lobster Shop* and *The Deer House* will be performed one after the other, will open at the Salzburger Festspiele and will also be shown in Zurich in December.

A cd and Jan Lauwers' first publication in German (Fischer Verlage) will also be presented in Salzburg. Both involve the words and music from *Isabella's room*, *The Lobster Shop* and *The Deer House*.

The Porcelain Project, by Grace Ellen Barkey & Needcompany, will this summer be at ImPulsTanz and La Bâtie (Festival de Genève). It will then journey on to Glasgow, Toulouse, Guimaraes, Frankfurt, Tongeren and Zurich. Arnd Wesemann of Ballet-Tanz declared this production 'a true masterpiece'.

Lemm&Barkey's work in porcelain features in Fragiles (May 2008), a prestigious international book that also contains work by Marcel Wanders, Arne Quinze, Jurgen Bey and others.

In October 2008 Lemm&Barkey will be exhibiting a new sculpture at the Guislain Museum in Ghent.

The Ballad of Ricky and Ronny – a pop opera by MaisonDahlBonnema has been selected for the 2008 Theatre Festival (Belgium) and TF (Theatre Festival of the Netherlands and Flanders). Between the two Theatre Festivals they will be performing at Noorderzon. Then on to Ljubljana, Stockholm, Malmo, Toulouse, Brussels (rerun), Arles, Antwerp and Mechelen.

So Man, by Maarten Seghers & OHNO COOPERATION will be part of 'an OHNO cooperation evening' in Frankfurt in November. The video of this performance was shown at the Movement Research Festival in New York in early June this year.

The Lobster Shop, by Jan Lauwers & Needcompany, closes Kampnagel's Internationales Sommerfestival in Hamburg and can also be seen at La Bâtie (Festival de Genève). It will later also be performed in Glasgow, Toulouse and Bruges.
